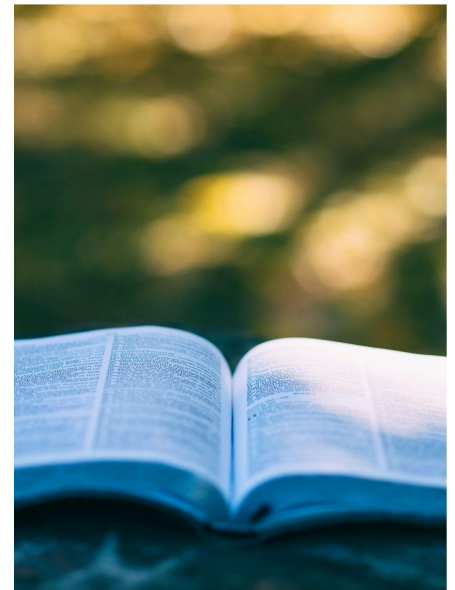
Partnering with Uganda Baptist Seminary for new Masters Cohort Program

Thanks to your contributions, JKD Evangelism is able to provide tuition for ten students to complete a Master's degree through Southeastern Seminary, Wake Forest. The program will be taught at UBS by Southeastern faculty. Students are coming from a variety of locales and tribes and countries including Uganda, Sudan, Tanzania, and Kenya. The program will open the students to more ministry possibilities and will address strict government restrictions that limit students without advanced ministry degrees from running churches that own property, etc.

- One student was once a witch doctor alongside his brother. When four girls died in their village, his brother was jumped and killed. The demons he communed with didn't help. But God doesn't leave. He stays.
