Sandra Returns to Uganda

In July, Sandra returned to Uganda with a mission team from her church. This was the first time she has been back in the country that captured her heart in a number of years. The ladies team taught 8 different Conferences on 2 Islands and 6 villages around Jinja and Pallisa. Most of the churches had been planted by men who attended Uganda Baptist Seminary. The people on the islands do not have running water or electricity, and most never leave their home on Lake Victoria for their entire lives. This was a unique opportunity for believers to be encouraged and the lost to hear the Gospel.

Teaching at Conferences

During these conferences, part of the team taught the pastors, while Sandra and other women leaders taught ladies from Titus Chapter 2. The lesson addressed how to live out being a godly woman under God's grace, and producing good works through the grace of God.

Everyone who attended the conference received the book of Titus in the Ugandan language. They had multiple translators and multiple languages teaching to a variety of people groups. These books will likely be the only bibles they will ever receive.
